RECOMMENDED UNDERSTORY TREES

The following species are required for planting within the City of Spanish Fort. Other species that are recognized as suitable for this area may be used if approved by the Building Official. Species native to coastal Alabama (Baldwin, Escambia and Mobile Counties) are preferred in most cases.

Carpinus caroliniana	American Hornbeam
Chamaecyparis thyoides	Atlantic White Cedar
Chionanthus virginicus	Fringe-tree/Graybeard
Crataegus marshallii spp.	Parsley Native Hawthorne
Ginkgo biloba	Ginkgo/Maidenhair Tree (use male plants only)
Halesia caroliniana	Carolina Silverbell
Halesia dipteral	Two-wing Silverbell
Ilex spp.	Holly/Ilex (arborescent species native to coastal Alabama)
Juniperus virginiana	Eastern Red cedar
Juniperus silicicola	Southern Red cedar
Lagerstroemia spp.	Crape-myrtle (varieties over fifteen (15) feet tall at maturity)
Magnolia spp.	Magnolia (any species native to coastal Alabama plus arborescent deciduous oriental varieties)
Nyssa ogeche	Ogeeche Gum
Ostrya virginiana	Eastern Hophornbeam
Oxydendrum arboretum	Sourwood
Persea borbonia	Redbay
Styrax americanum	American Snowbell
Ulmus parvifolia	Chinese Elm
