



JOB ANNOUNCEMENT CERTIFIED POLICE OFFICER

Summary

Under the direction of the Chief of Police, this position exists to provide safety and well-being of the general public, to deter criminal activity within our community, to enforce all city, state and applicable federal laws, statutes, codes and ordinances and to perform a variety of general law enforcement functions which consist of but are not limited to: patrol, court services, investigations, arrests, assist and/or provide traffic control and to perform other police related duties as required. This employee may be assigned other duties that are not specifically included.

Minimum Qualifications

Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent; possess and maintain a valid Alabama driver's license and be insurable by the City's Insurance Provider; be able to work 12-hours shifts, including days, nights, weekends and holidays and must currently possess a certification with the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission (A.P.O.S.T.C.) for law enforcement officers. The applicant must submit to a physical and psychological evaluation in the nature of that established by Alabama Administrative Code Rules 650-X-2-.04 for candidates attending APOST certified police academies.

Rate of Pay

The rate of pay for this position is \$22.38 per hour (\$48,873.38.00 annually), based on an 84 hour schedule per two-week work period. The City of Spanish Fort offers excellent benefits to full time employees working a minimum of 40 hours per week including: Health and Dental Insurance for individuals and families; state retirement plans; sick and vacation leave and paid holidays.
