

JOB POSTING POLICE DISPATCHER (PART TIME)

Summary

Under immediate direction this position will monitor radio and telephone emergency calls; relay the necessary information to patrol units and emergency personnel. Maintain a radio log and other records and perform clerical duties, as necessary. This employee will also perform related work in other areas as needed.

Minimum Qualifications

Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent; possess and maintain a valid Alabama driver's license and be insurable by the City's Insurance Provider. Applicants must be willing to work up to 12-hour shifts, including days, nights, weekends and holidays. The City of Spanish Fort offers excellent benefits to full time employees working a minimum of 40 hours per week including: health and dental Insurance for individuals and families; state retirement plans; sick and vacation leave and paid holidays. A current certificate with the Alabama National Crime Information Center is preferred.
