CITY OF SPANISH FORT MUNICIPAL COURT INDIGENT DEFENSE ATTORNEY POSITION

The City of Spanish Fort is seeking qualified candidates for the position of part-time Municipal Court Indigent Defense Attorney. This attorney will serve as appointed defense attorney for those defendants who are deemed by the Municipal Judge to be indigent and unable to afford an attorney during the Spanish Fort Municipal Court monthly dockets. Responsibilities include: negotiating cases and plea agreements; representing defendants during bench and jury trials; presenting motions, pleadings, and arguments in court; and interviewing witnesses, Police Officers, victims, and others. Applicants must be a qualified elector of the State of Alabama and licensed to practice law in the State of Alabama. This position is appointed by the Spanish Fort City Council.

Spanish Fort Municipal Court is held on the fourth Thursday of each month beginning at 2:30 p.m. each month except during the month of December when court is not held, and the months of April and September when court is held on the third Thursday. Pay for this position shall be \$600 per month. This position shall be deemed a contract position.

Interested candidates should submit a cover letter and resume detailing experience and education including a summary of work history by 4:00 p.m., Thursday, May 29, 2025.
